Imposing sentence when the defendant is serving or will serve an undischarged term of Imprisonment or has an anticipated state term of Imprisonment.

This information details how the Federal Bureau of Prisons (BOP) computes federal sentences generally. The information then focuses on the impact on the federal sentence computation when the defendant is under the primary jurisdiction of non-federal authorities.



Primer

<u>This primer</u> discusses guideline provisions and case law addressing some of the most commonly applied grounds for departure from a defendant's guideline range. It also addresses issues relating to variances outside the guideline range. Although the primer identifies some of the key cases and concepts related to sentencing departures and variances, it is not a comprehensive compilation of authority nor intended to be a substitute for independent research and analysis of primary sources.
